INTENDED USE

Hardy Diagnostics CRITERIONTM Maltose is a chemically pure disaccharide which can be used in bacteriological culture media. It is used in the monohydrate form.

This is a raw material intended to be used in the making of prepared media products, which will require further processing, additional ingredients, or supplements.

SUMMARY

CRITERIONTM Maltose (4-O-a-D-Glucopyranosyl-D-gluscose) or malt sugar is often used as a nutrient in culture media.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store the sealed bottle(s) containing dehydrated culture medium at 2-30°C. Dehydrated culture medium is very hygroscopic. Keep lid tightly sealed. Protect dehydrated culture media from moisture and light. The dehydrated culture media should be discarded if it is not free-flowing or if the color has changed from its original white.

The expiration date on the product label applies to the product in its intact packaging when stored as directed. The product may be used and tested up to the expiration date on the product label and incubated for the recommended incubation times as stated below.

PRECAUTIONS
