### **Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for Sedi-Rate™ and Sedigren™ Westergren ESR Systems**

Sedi-Rate® and Sedigren™ both of which contain 0.25mL of 3.8% sodium citrate diluent, are considered non-hazardous products according to Federal and OSHA regulations. Therefore an MSDS is not required for either of these products.
